

INSTRUMENT ASSISTED SOFT TISSUE MOBILISATION LEVEL 1

Course Over view:

Instrument assisted soft tissue mobilization, or IASTM, is the use of specialized tools to perform Myofascial or soft tissue work. It is an alternate treatment option that a trained therapist may use to resolve pain and tightness.

Course contents:

The objective of this course is to teach Instrument Assisted Soft Tissue Mobilisation (IASTM) techniques which are designed to give you the underpinning knowledge required to get the best results from working with this increasingly popular technique. You will be able to use this technique the very next day after the course.

Whether you are a therapist with an injured patient or a trainer who's client needs more range of movement through various areas of their body, this technique will enhance your current clinical outcome. Instrument-assisted soft tissue mobilization (IASTM) enables clinicians to effectively break down scar tissue, fascial restrictions, Myofascial trigger points, adhesions and change muscle tonus.

The technique utilizes a specifically designed stainless steel instrument which is used to both assess and treat areas exhibiting soft tissue dysfunction. By the end of the course, the participants should be able to correctly identify and treat soft tissue dysfunctions that are amenable to treatment through the use of this modality.
